Transition to lead free plumbing products starts now

A 3-year transition period to support Australia's path to reducing allowable lead levels in many plumbing products has commenced. The Lead Free WaterMark trademark has been registered and WaterMark Notice of Direction 2021/4.2 Certification transition arrangements for lead free plumbing products has been publisched on the ABCB website. All relevant plumbing products being installed must meet the new requirements by 1 May 2026.
